Panel Structure Argentina W1-W2

Previous reports stated that the second wave of data collection in Argentina managed to reinterview 784 participants. During the process of cleaning and data matching, the data provided by our polling counterparts could not successfully match the identities of 30 participants who were originally categorized as panel returns between waves 1 and 2. Therefore, the actual number of participants who were re-interviewed was 754.
